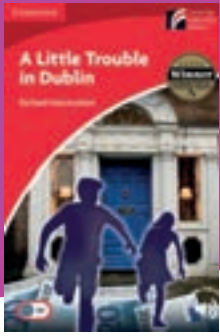

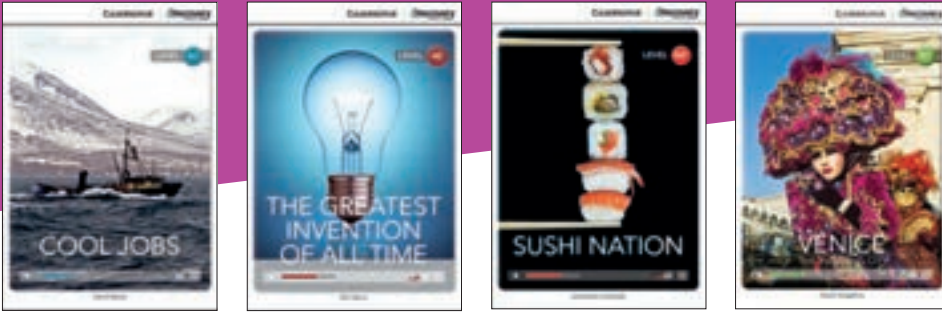

**Video Quest** **A Great White Shark's Meal**

Watch this video to learn about great white sharks. Why do so many sharks go to this area near the feature Islands?

It may seem like 21 kilograms is a lot of food, but it is only about 2 percent of the whale shark's weight. Like people, most species of sharks only eat about 2 percent of their weight a day. That's not very much at all. In fact, one of the shark's prey, eat about 6 percent of their weight, and looms, a type of bird, eat 22 percent of their weight a day!

People think sharks are always eating, but some sharks don't even eat every day. They have a lot of teeth, but they can't chew<sup>1</sup> their food very well, so they have to swallow it in big pieces. Because of that it takes them a long time to digest<sup>2</sup> their food. And they have to let it digest before they can eat again.

<sup>1</sup>Sharks' teeth break down their prey into small pieces of meat.  
<sup>2</sup>Digestion changes food so the stomach can use it.
